If you're reading this, there is a high likelihood that you've come across one or more of the tracks from my Ebenezer album. I wanted to try and collate all of the chord charts for the album in one place – (a) because this makes it easier for people to access and (b) there's a higher chance that if you consider using one of my songs, you might consider more if you have all the chord charts together!

So – what is this album all about? Here's the information from the inside of the physical CD:

These songs were primarily written through 2020 and 2021, where the world was brought to a standstill due to COVID-19. Our expression of church changed, our grip on normality changed, and freedoms that so many of us never needed to question were taken from us. This album captures some of those experiences, seeking to draw from them lessons that we can learn.

The title track Ebenezer takes its reference from the story found in 1 Samuel 7, where Samuel places a stone as a visual reminder of God's provision and help up to that point. A sign of a God who was faithful, hinting of a God who would remain faithful. And maybe all of us can find some use in that symbolism with all the things that we have lived through.

I hope that you enjoy this album. Many songs have been influenced so heavily by the 12 Song Challenge songwriting community that I am part of, and I know that the creative outlet that this has provided me with has played a large part in helping me survive in a world that was locked down. My prayer is that as you listen to this album, you too will be reminded of a God who is faithful, and draw your confidence from that, knowing that he will remain faithful. Always. Whatever our circumstances seem to say.
